

## Annex I: List of European states with <0.5% GHG emissions

We define small states in a European context in relational terms (Thorhallsson and Wivel 2006) as countries accounting for no more than 0.5% of global greenhouse gas emissions in 2012. We use emissions data from the “Climate Analysis Indicators Tool” compiled by the World Resources Institute ([www.cait.wri.org](http://www.cait.wri.org)). Below is a table listing all European countries (both EU and non-EU) that fulfil the condition set out above.
